Resident Tuition with College Opportunity Fund (COF)	
24.5 credits (Nursing curriculum) x\$230.70 =	\$5,625.15
26 credits (General Education) x \$153.35 =	\$3,987.10
Total cost =	\$9,612.25

Resident Tuition without College Opportunity Fund (COF)	
24.5 credits (Nursing curriculum) x\$324.70 =	\$7,955.15
26 credits (General Education) x \$247.35 =	\$6,431.10
Total cost =	\$14,386.25

Non-Resident Tuition
